

Reports of various activities of NSS Unit 1 of Maynaguri College during 2020-2021

1. Due to severe Covid situation volunteers of NSS Unit 1 had celebrated Independence Day in virtual mode. They made various posters and performed virtual cultural programme.
2. On 25th August, 2020, some volunteers of NSS Unit 1 have helped some families of migrant workers of their neighbourhood with food grains and clothes. They had done this amazing job from their own savings.
3. Between 4th September to 12th October, 2020 some volunteers were given free coaching to the children of their locality who were not able to go to school due to school being closed for Corona.
4. During the Corona crisis, experts determined that spitting spreads the virus, chewing tobacco, gutkha, khaini, etc. cause the urge to spit and hence the Government, under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 gave the order to stop spitting in public places and the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, himself, urged the public to do so too. On behalf of 'Pledge for Life' team an initiative had taken, that was National Level Spitting Kills campaign. They also requested National Service Scheme to support this campaign. So volunteers of NSS Unit 1 of Maynaguri College created awareness among public on the issue and got 275 positive responses to this. It was conducted between August to 25th October, 2020.
5. Three-Day(From 17 October to 19th October, 2020) State-Level Lecture Series in online mode has organized by NSS Unit 1 of Maynaguri College in collaboration of Siliguri Mahila Mahavidyalaya on Gandhian Values and Praxis: some reflections. More than 500 participants from various part of the state have participated. On 17th October, 2020, the inaugural session have started with the gracious presence of Smt. Susmita Pandit, TIC of Maynaguri College, Dr. Subrata Debnath, Principal of Siliguri Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Mr. Agnimeel Das, Youth Officer of the Regional Directorate, NSS, Kolkata, Dr. Monoranjan Chowdhury, NSS Coordinator, North Bengal University. 6. 52 volunteers of NSS Unit 1 of Maynaguri College have celebrated International Day for the Older Person in a different way. Most of them visited some aged women of their

neighbourhood to spend some quality time with them. They also gifted them new saree and other necessary things for Durga Puja ceremony.

7. On 24th September, 2020 NSS Day celebrated by all the NSS Units of the College. Almost 50 volunteers from NSS Unit1 have participated. They made a rangoli of NSS Logo in front of the Principal's chamber. Programme had started by the flag hoisting by our TiC Smt. Susmita Pandit. Volunteers had participated in a small colourful cultural programme. We had to curtail the programme to maintain the Covid protocol. Unit Volunteers also cleaned the garden before the Programme. An online quiz programme was also organized.
8. On the eve of NSS Day celebration some volunteers of Unit 1 had done some appreciable job. Some of them had helped some neighboring children of their locality with some important educational materials and clothes to whom they gave free tuition also because they thought due to long gap of physical classroom in the Covid pandemic situation education in school children should not be deprived of getting primary education.
